

Advanced mappings




From Zero to EJB3 Demo

EJB3 Step-by-Step - Part 2

Add POJOs to src/java

- Update DataSource.groovy
 - configClass = GrailsAnnotationConfiguration.class
- Define hibernate.cfg.xml

Place constraint scripts alongside POJOs

Foo.java maps to FooContraints.groovy
